- Delivery Format – Online
- Number of Credit Hours - 30
- Students take 6 hours in the summer to prepare for the internship (Advanced Clinical Nutrition & Integrated Food System Management) and additional 6 hours of coursework that are integrated in with internship experiences. (Clinical Nutrition Management & Advanced Food Service Systems Management)
- Ranking - Top ranked online Master's in Nutrition in the U.S. as reported by GoGrad.org.
- Tuition – Out-of-state tuition rates are waived, online graduate tuition is \$420/credit hour (2019-20 academic year).
- Financial Aid – Available for those who qualify.

Master of Science in Human Nutrition

The University of Alabama has partnered with free-standing dietetic internships to provide Interns with the opportunity to enroll in the MS Human Nutrition program. The program is creatively designed to provide foundation knowledge in the summer before rotations start and to coordinate coursework and assignments with the internship rotations. Internship directors work directly with university faculty to align assignments and activities, and most students complete the degree within one year of finishing the program. Acceptance into the program occurs after computer match, and out of state tuition rates are waived. Financial aid is available to eligible students to cover tuition and living expenses, and there is no need for additional letters of recommendation or GRE Scores. The M.S. in Human Nutrition is designed to prepare nutrition professionals to practice dietetics at an advanced level and/or to pursue doctoral study. This fully-online program develops advanced-level practitioner skills, stimulates independent thought, and provides up-to-date knowledge in food and nutrition.
